

PubMed LinkOut to Full Text at UMHS

The **PubMed LinkOut** service connecting you to an article's full text, now includes the journal holdings of the **Anne Ross Library**. Follow the link from the [Anne Ross Library Home](#) page to the [PubMed search interface](#) (link in the left sidebar).

Then when you perform your literature search in **PubMed**, if the article you discover is available in full text from our **EBSCOHost** journal subscription databases (such as **Medline Complete**), you will notice the **UMHS logo** icon in the top right of the PubMed article citation record.

NOTE: You must also be logged into your free personal **MyNCBI** account which you create for yourself. Click link in top right area of PubMed search screen.

Then just click on the icon and arrive at the corresponding **UMHS EBSCO** citation record for that same article, along with the link it contains to the full text PDF.

Set up your own, free, [MyNCBI](#) account on the PubMed site so you can save all your searches, have remote access to LinkOut, among other things!
