

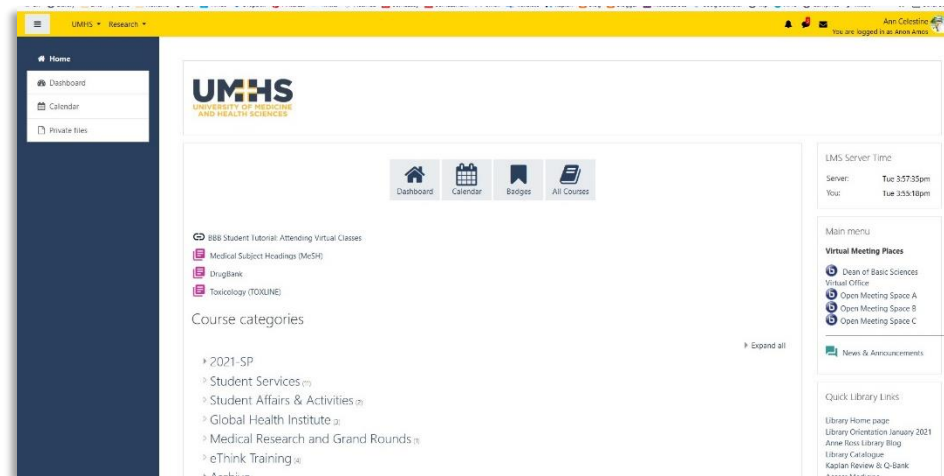

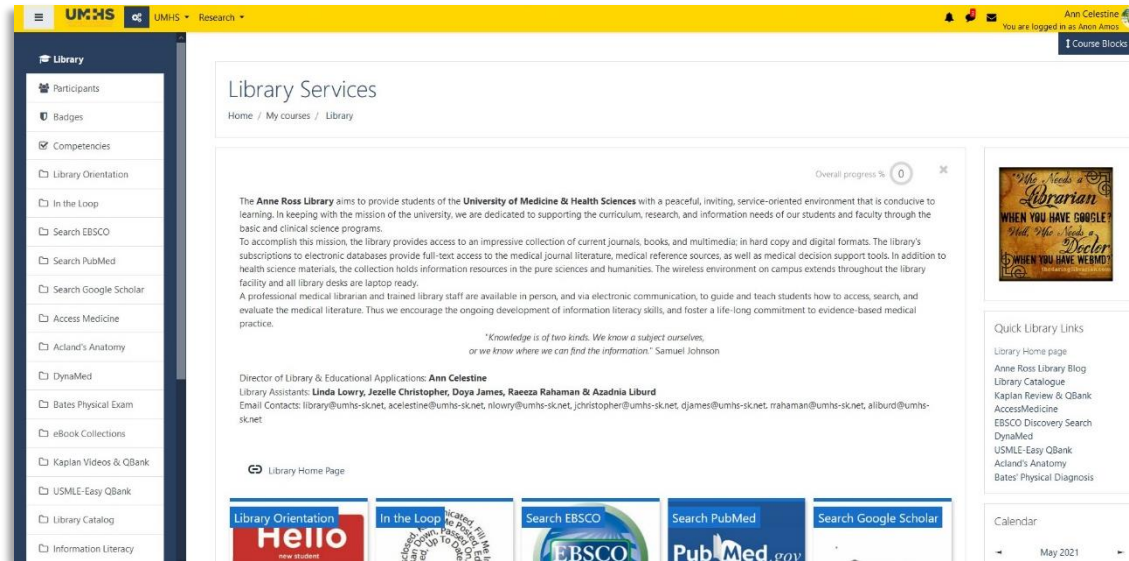

Degrees of thrombocytopenia may be classified by the following platelet thresholds:

- Mild: 100,000 to 150,000/microL
- Moderate: 50,000 to 99,000/microL
- Severe: <50,000/microL
- Very severe: <20,000/microL

Severe thrombocytopenia confers a greater risk of bleeding, particularly in the presence of other risk factors (eg, anticoagulation, antiplatelet agents). Very severe thrombocytopenia confers a greater risk of spontaneous bleeding in most conditions and the likelihood for needing urgent treatment. However, the correlation between the platelet count and the risk of bleeding varies according to the underlying condition and may be unpredictable.
